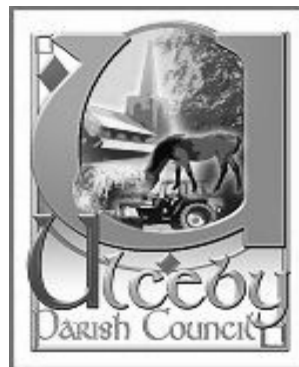

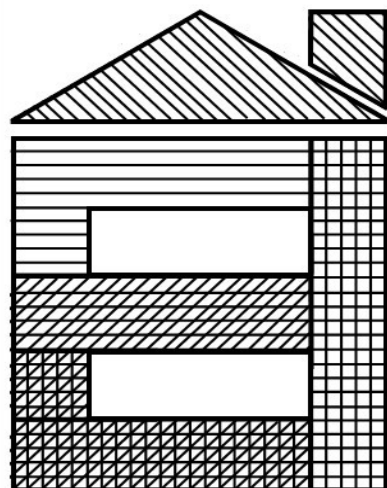
CHAIRMAN'S REPORT APRIL 2015 – MARCH 2016

Members of the Parish Council have, on two occasions, had site meetings in the village with representatives of North Lincolnshire Council, regarding inconsiderate parking and the possibility of increasing the number of double yellow lines at points regarded as safety hazards. At the time of writing, we are waiting further developments in this regard.

The Parish Council have decided to update the village website so, within a short while, the new website address will be www.ulcebyparishcouncil.co.uk. This decision has, partly, become necessary to fall in line with new Government legislation regarding Parish Council websites. We offer our sincere thanks to Mr Alan Winstanley who, up until this point, has maintained and updated the previous website entirely at his own expense. Thank you Mr Winstanley, your support of the Parish Council is really appreciated.

Similarly, in line with new planning rules, (S106 funding) the Keigar Development at Gowers Farm paid into North Lincolnshire Council the sum of £5450.00 – this money had to be used for recreational development in the village. In consequence, arrangements are in hand for the erection of a new wall on the village playing field to be used, primarily, as an opportunity for children to test their football and other ball skills without using the walls and doors of the Village Hall itself!! Unfortunately, through overall rising costs, we have had to arrange to increase the village precept by a total of £1000.00. The precept has been fixed at its present rate of £12,500 since 2009 and by judicious accounting, we have been able to maintain this. However, to meet rising costs, we have now found it necessary to make an increase in the precept. As an example, this will result in the owners of a village property in Band D having to pay an additional **14 pence per month**, from the current £21.26 to £22.93 per year. Other properties will be charged on a pro-rata basis. We have tried to keep this additional increase to the minimum to allow us to continue to offer the best service to you that we can.

Thanks to all those householders who, last summer, took note of our request to cut back overhanging trees and protruding hedges. The Parish Council themselves have arranged for the trees and hedges at the Parish Pump in Coronation Road to be trimmed back shortly. A new contract has been negotiated with North Lincolnshire Council to tend the flower baskets and millennium garden planting in the village, with these costs rising slightly in line with inflation.

North Lincolnshire Council are trialling a one-year minibus transport scheme in Scawby called Call Connect and this will soon be extended to include Ulceby. To use this service, it will be necessary for residents to register with the group, but current holders of free bus passes will enjoy this service free of charge; with other users being required to pay a charge to use this transport. Arrangements can be made for your travel requirements up to 7 days in advance. Please watch the local press and the News Direct magazine from North Lincolnshire for details (see also page 9).

I have tried to summarise here some of the arrangements and decisions made by your Parish Council during the last year but obviously, this is not a complete picture, and to really find out what goes on at our monthly meetings, we would invite you to attend any one of them – they take place in the village hall at 7.00 pm on the third Monday of each month. These are formal meetings but are held in a friendly and lively atmosphere with Parish Councillors who care about our village and who should be commended for giving freely of their time for your benefit.

These are good people and deserve your support – I am privileged to be part of this supportive group.

NEW FACILITY AT THE VILLAGE HALL

Ulceby Parish Council has been given the opportunity of providing new facilities for the village, which has been made possible from funding supplied from the development at Gowers Farm.

The funding was specifically for improving or upgrading recreational facilities in Ulceby, to make improvements at the central communal playing field site to serve the whole community, and the Parish Council tasked the Village Hall Committee to put forward the best option for the young people of the village.

Various suggestions were made by the Committee on new play equipment inside the play area, but finally decided that most youngsters enjoyed kicking a football against a wall. Cost were obtained which came in on budget and a site was decided upon. It was further suggested that perhaps the wall could be floodlit so that games could be played throughout the darker winter nights, and again the committee agreed that this would be possible with an infra red sensor to activate the flood light; costing for this is now in progress but it is hoped that it will still be in budget.

An impression of what it will look like and the location is in the above picture and the wall size is approximately 7 metres wide by 3 metres high with a goal and basket ball hoop.

It is hoped that with the new rebound wall, youngsters will be encouraged to use it and not kick a ball against the Village Hall which is suffering damage from this action!

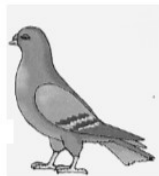

.....SECURITY CHECKED

SATELLITE NAVIGATION EQUIPMENT



When buying satellite navigation equipment, check that it has anti-theft security features. Make a note of the make, model and serial number and keep it in a safe place, but not in your car. Always take portable navigation systems, together with the support cradle and suction pads with you when you leave the car. Remember to wipe away any marks left on the windscreen.

KEEP YOUR KEYS SAFE

Remember to keep your keys in a safe place at all times. Remove the ignition key every time you leave your vehicle, even when you are filling your car with petrol or just popping into the newsagents, and particularly if you warm your car up in the winter. It only takes a few seconds for someone to jump into your car and drive away.

Lock all doors, close all windows and shut the sunroof every time you leave your car, however briefly. Many cars get broken into in the few seconds that the car is out of the driver's sight. You should also have a lockable fuel cap.

DOORS AND WINDOWS



SECURITY MARKING

Consider marking all your valuables, including the stereo and things that you often take in your car. Use a unique identifying number (either one that is linked to a recognised database or the vehicle registration number) or use your postcode, and keep a note of any serial numbers in a safe place. Marking can help trace an item that's yours as well as the person who stole it. Ask the crime prevention officer at your local police station about marking schemes.

CAR SECURITY CHECK.....

Locks or other security devices will always put criminals off. You can get information about vehicle immobilisers and other security products by calling the Vehicle Security National Helpline on 0870 550 2006. Make sure any device is approved by a recognised organisation such as Thatcham (0870 550 2006) or Sold Secure (01327 264687). Electronic immobilisers are effective against thieves but must be professionally fitted (for example, by main dealers or fitters approved by the Vehicle Systems Installation Board).



SECURITY DEVICES



IMMOBILISERS

Many thieves target wheels. To protect your wheels and tyres, fit locking wheel nuts. They are not expensive and are easy to fit.

Mechanical immobilisers, such as steering wheel locks, are not expensive and are easy to use.



BELONGINGS

Even an old coat on the back seat is a target for someone to smash a window and grab it. Don't leave anything on display. If you have to leave items in your car, put them out of sight at the start of your journey.



ETCHING

Arrange to have the vehicle registration number etched on to all glass surfaces, including headlights. Or, you can use the last seven digits of the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) or a unique identifying number that is linked to a recognised database (Loss Prevention Council standards 1224 and 1225).



CallConnect Pilot in North Lincolnshire

People living in the rural areas of North Lincolnshire will benefit from the introduction of a new bus service. The new service is called 'CallConnect' and enables you to call for a bus to pick you up.

It is based on the CallConnect model already used by Lincolnshire County Council. In order to use the service you must register first. You can do this by telephone 0345 2638139 or by the council's email www.northlincs.gov.uk and follow the public transport pages.

The service operates from **7am to 7pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm on Saturdays**. A bus will operate in each of the four zones:

Brigg, Caistor and the Ridge ward

Ferry ward
(which includes Ulceby)

The area north of Scunthorpe including Burton upon Stather and Winterton
Isle of Axholme

The Brigg, Caistor and Ridge Ward service started on 15 February 2016. The other 3 areas are expected to be in operation in May 2016.

The purpose of the service is to take you to a local centre or allow you to connect with an existing bus or rail service. The service will not compete with local bus services. Once registered you can make your booking request. Once again this can be done on-line (available 24/7) or by telephone during the above hours. The booking team will then confirm your journey times. The service uses a number of pick up points identified in North Lincolnshire. On the day of your journey go to your pick up point at the date and time you were given. When the bus arrives you pay your fare or show your concessionary pass.

If you suffer from limited mobility then discuss this when you register as there might be an opportunity to pick you up closer to home.

The buses are 16 seater minibuses with wheelchair access.
