- iii) To give consideration to the information received from Roy Hindmarsh regarding the hire of flashing speed awareness signs and to discuss and agree suitable locations for such signs along with the length of hire period and set a budget for the hire of these signs.  
**IT WAS RESOLVED** to investigate the possibility of hiring 2 signs for a 6 month period for each sign. The signs are to be located around the Southfield Close area on Station Road – entering the village from the motorway and on West End Road – as you enter the village from Croxton – just after the 30mph sign (just before the cottages) on the left hand side. Clerk to invite Roy Hindmarsh to inspect the locations and commence proceedings.
- iv) To note the allocation of £1000 from N.L.C – N.Lincs in Bloom initiative – It was noted that a display or feature should be centrally situated in the village or located to the entrance of the village. Clerk to investigate the ownership of the land to the front of Advent Court (Right hand side as you enter Advent Court) and report to next meeting.
- v) Community Planting – summer bedding plants – troughs, millennium planter and Martins Road beds – to advise the clerk has invited tenders from various companies. Just one tender received at present – clerk to chase up outstanding quotations with a view of making a decision at the next parish council meeting.

## 10. NORTH LINCOLNSHIRE COUNCIL MATTERS

- iv. New N.L.C highways matters – Cllr Caygill-Ogden raised again the condition of the footpath on Brocklesby Road. It was felt that the footpath has not been scraped back and sections of it are too narrow. A member of the public who walks with the aid of a walking frame has indicated that he is finding it difficult to negotiate the path. Clerk to raise again with Darren Uzzell at N.L.C.

The dog bin on Thornton lane is always overflowing. A member of the public has removed the full bag and left it by the side of the bin and placed a new bag within the bin. N.L.C, when attending the bin, have chosen to leave the full bag next to the bin and not disposed of it. The grass mowers have even cut around the bag ! Clerk to raise this with N.L.C and ask if this bin can be emptied more regularly – or a larger bin placed in this location.

The bollard at West End Road junction is damaged.

Fly Tipping in West End Road Lay-By.

Pavement outside The Fox Inn on Front Street is broken up and uneven along with the pavement from the car park in Hallcroft to no.4 and also the pavement along High Street up to the new piece of pavement – left hand side – opposite the Fish and Chip shop.
