#### <u>ULCEBY PARISH COUNCIL – CHAIRMAN'S AUTUMN 2017 UPDATE</u>

You will have noticed that, at last, the new notice board has been erected outside the village hall and because of the recycled material which has been used to make it, this should now stand for many years. The footpath along Brocklesby Road has been partially cleared back to allow better access to pedestrians but further work is necessary, and some of the hedges throughout the village have been tidied. The dog bin at the Village Pump has now been repositioned in Station Road where it meets the footpath through to Thornton Lane, and a new dog bin will be erected shortly. further along Brocklesby Road in the direction of the flyover.

Cllr Clark of NLC reported on a meeting he had attended with the Drainage Division of North Lincolnshire Council when he had been assured that the proposed replacement of drainage through Coronation Road/junction with Spruce Lane would be completed by 31 March 2018. Anglian Water would also be part of the scheme, thereby ensuring that only one set of road works would need to take place. However, Anglian Water placed a caveat that, should an emergency arise elsewhere, they would need to be free to attend that work in preference. As a consequence, it had been agreed that a two month extension to the commencement of the work might be necessary.

The extension of double yellow lines along Front Street have received approval and in an attempt to reduce traffic, at the completion of the roadwork's on the A180, we requested that a sign be erected at the Truck Stop, directing leaving lorries back towards the A180 to encourage drivers to avoid the village. At the time of writing, a sign is still awaited. Quotations for the hire of two flashing speed signs at the main entrances to the village have been received and agreed and these will be installed shortly following advice from the Highways Division regarding the best locations for them. Agreement has also been reached for a 'No Waiting At Any Time' area to be designated around all the roadway of the new Co-Op store.

We will be taking part, later in the year, in the North Lincolnshire in Bloom initiative run by North Lincolnshire Council and this will see a new flower and plant feature developed towards the village centre. We are also awaiting 3 quotations to continue with the already established Community Planting of summer bedding in the Millennium garden, Martins Road flower beds and troughs etc.



#### "Wot's goin' on?"

In this village there are two organisations that are devoted to the smooth running of village issues. One being the Parish Council and the other the Village Hall Committee.

The Parish Council meets every third Monday of the month and concerns itself with issues raised that affect YOU. There is a misconception that the Parish Council does nothing, and although it's powers are limited it can affect how things are happening. Usually I sit alone in the meetings unless something (a planning application or flooding directly affects one of the villagers) is up for discussion. When this is the case, perhaps one or two residents attend, but planning and flooding are just two of the agenda items.

There are also a myriad of what are considered minor items ranging from mowing, flower arrangements, public transport, dog and litter bins, dog fouling - list goes on.

#### Do you know what goes on and more importantly do you care?

The Village Hall Committee is a registered charity and is concerned with the upkeep and maintenance of the hall and playing field.

Most of the normal tasks are carried out by volunteers, although a weekly cleaner and maintenance man are employed just to keep the hall in a safe and usable condition.

The main area that needs extra volunteers is the mowing of grass. There are a lot of residents who enjoy walking the dog on the field or just by the pond sitting or playing with their children. With so few volunteers to help its is down to a very few, and I will say ageing, residents to keep the field maintained.

Both of these organisations are run for you and you should get involved and state your views or donate a little time after all a little time or effort makes a big difference.

#### **Reporting Petty Crime**

A number of petty crimes occurring in the village have been reported to the editor. For the police to be able to act on these incidents they must be informed and residents are reminded that the police can be contacted by ringing **101**. All calls are then added to the crime figures for this area and are discussed with Parish Council representatives from the surrounding area at the regular NATS meetings.

Alternatively villagers can voice their concerns at the Parish Council meetings held on the third Monday of each month.

However, this doesn't just apply to petty crime. **ANY** acts causing **YOU** distress be these via the mail or telephone companies asking for bank details and passwords (which you should **NEVER** give out) should be reported.

#### ST NICHOLAS CHURCH -RESTORATION REPORT

After five long years of fundraising we are able to bring you news of the start of the restoration and renovation work at the Church! The major renovation work is being funded by The Heritage Lottery Fund which is part of The National Lottery, so thank you to all of you who play The National Lottery. Additional funding is from The National Churches Trust.

The beginning of December will see the initial work taking place at St Nicholas with the real project beginning in January 2018. Initially the roofing will be replaced where necessary and the building made water-tight. At this same time, with the award from North Lincolnshire Council towards the cost of installing a toilet, and servery, work will begin on laying the necessary pipework.

We have discussed with the Managing Engineer the possibility of having a 'Hard Hat Day' during the several months of renovations - a day on which residents will be invited to book a visit to the top of the Church to view the work progressing and see the surrounding area of the village. This is an exciting phase for the Friends but we realise that it could not have been achieved without all the support and encouragement which you, the people of Ulceby, have shown us during this long fundraising period.
