ULCEBY PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S ANNUAL REPORT APRIL 2017 – MARCH 2018

I will try to outline here some of the achievements and decisions reached by your Parish Council during the last year.

An additional seat has been ordered for placement at the newly added pavement opposite the Co-Op store and prior to next winter, we intend to purchase an additional salt bin for this area too. Further dog bins have been purchased and sited around the village in the hope that full use will be made of these by the village's dog owners.

Following the intervention of Ward and Parish Councillors with the Police Authorities, use was re-established of the War Memorial for Remembrance Sunday and new flags were purchased for the refurbished flagpole there. Subsequently, Ulceby was awarded the Best Kept War Memorial in the Best Kept Village Competition.

A new village Notice Board, made from weatherproof recycled material, was purchased and erected outside the Village Hall.

Double yellow no-parking lines were extended on Front Street to include the entrance/exit to Yarborough Court. December saw the siting of flashing speed signs erected at both main entrances to the village which, hopefully, will reduce traffic speed, and a request has been made to NLC regarding possible traffic calming measures in Church Lane.

A decision was made to join the North Lincs in Bloom initiative which will see 3 additional flower beds sited at James Place and 3 troughs added to the railings at the village hall but because of support from NLC, this initiative will require minimum expenditure on our part.

Arrangements will be made to move the village defibrillator from outside the school to a more accessible site at the new Co-Op store.

At the January meeting our support for various local charities, including 'Lives', the Computer Club etc., and for the Royal British Legion was confirmed and it was unanimously agreed not to make any increase to the village precept for the coming year.

It is hoped that from July, there will be a monthly attendance at our meetings of our Community Policeman, P.C. Fuller.

This is only a brief overview of some of the work and decisions of your Parish Council during this last year and all villagers are welcome at any of our monthly meetings, held at 7.00 pm. on the third Monday each month. All of our Parish Councillors are committed to constantly work on your behalf for the care and improvement of our village. CALL CONNECT IMPROVEMENTS

The popular CallConnect bus service that provides a lifeline to many residents in rural areas is set to continue improving transport services across North Lincolnshire.

More than 3,000 people have already registered to use CallConnect – it provides a more flexible service for residents in areas that are currently poorly served by traditional bus services.

The Humber Flyer (Grimsby to Hull) will be enhanced to include the Airport and villages along the A1077. This would provide an improved service for residents living in Ulceby, Wootton, Thornton Curtis and Barrow, Hull or Grimsby.

Councillor Richard Hannigan, cabinet member for safer, greener and cleaner places at North Lincolnshire Council, said: "We are continuing to invest heavily in public transport in North Lincolnshire. Our concessionary fares scheme which provides bus passes to older and disabled residents is one of the best in the country and we can be proud that this is available to residents in our area. As customers demand for public transport changes, we need to consider ways we can improve transport further to better meet their needs. We have found that some routes are less popular than others and there is demand to expand services in other areas. "We have addressed this and are planning to have a much more flexible bus service that works with the popular CallConnect and other main bus routes.

"We are also investing to expand the CallConnect bus service. These changes will greatly improve the offer to residents and create a more flexible approach to transport. We should remember that CallConnect provides a service that operates between 7am and 7pm Monday to Friday and between 8am and 6pm on Saturday."

CallConnect is a unique bus service with no fixed timetable, but instead responds to passenger requests. Routes are different each day depending on the bookings made by passengers. Journey requests can be made by telephone or online.

All are welcome to use the service regardless of age or status. You can use the service as frequently as required for anything from shopping or travelling to work or school, to a social event or medical appointment. Contact the booking centre to register and find out how CallConnect can help you.

You can book a CallConnect journey online or by calling the booking team on 0345 2638139.

When requesting a bus journey, have your membership number and journey details ready. You can also submit your travel requests online. You can make a booking up to seven days in advance and on the same day with a minimum of one hour's notice.



Thanks to your fantastic support the installation of an internal toilet and servery is now complete. The craftsmanship of the woodwork is a joy to behold. As well as your contributions, the work has been supported through a grant from the Allchurches Trust Ltd., and from North Lincs Council.

Thanks must go also to Mr P Clark, our former Mayor and present Ward Councillor, who supported our application to NLC for financial assistance. Because of the almost imminent start of the main remedial work to the roof, which limits our ability to offer an opportunity to celebrate the installations, we have decided to wait until the roof works, heating and lighting are completed (towards the year end) before we stage a Celebration of Completion of the whole project.

In addition to our Project Completion Celebration, we have a really full programme of events and planned usage of the church next year so that the whole community can benefit from its restoration.

Please watch for announcements and information in the forthcoming months, via The Parish Link Magazine. The tower of pennies towards the restoration of the Tower at a later stage, is still very much 'alive' and the total collected to date is £241 which, you will recall, is just over half of one of the three exposed tower sides (each equals £407.94) with a total of £1223.82 needed to achieve the total aim. Mrs Smith at the new Co-Op Post Office is able to hand out and take in any filled jars.

Finally, please accept our grateful thanks for all that you have done and continue to do to support our efforts. It is almost 6 years since our Church was under threat of closure and, together, not only have we avoided that tragedy, but at the end of the renovation works, we will have a beautifully restored, warm, well-lit and friendly 11th century building to offer to you and to forthcoming generations.
