

## **PLANNING APPLICATION FOR 90 DWELLINGS – STATION ROAD, ULCEBY.**

Planning Application 2018/2525 – Outline planning permission to erect 90 dwellings and access with appearance, landscaping, layout and scale reserved for subsequent approval – Land at Station Road, Ulceby.

This proposed development is to be situated to the East of Gower Close within an agricultural field. Ulceby Parish council has objected to this planning application and it will be heard by the planning committee – possibly on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019.

Confirmation of whether this application is to be heard on 3/7/19 will not be provided until 7 days prior to the meeting date.

None of the Parish Councillors will be able to speak specifically on this application. If you wish your views to be heard, you will have to register and speak at the meeting. You may also raise the issue with your **Ward Councillors** who can speak at the planning meeting (If they attend) their contact details are on the Parish Council website and below. You may contact the Parish Councillors at any time, but they will not be able to speak at this meeting.
