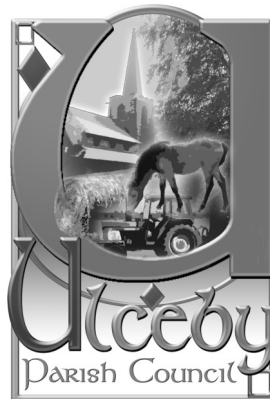

ULCEBY PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S ANNUAL REPORT APRIL 2018 – MARCH 2019

In this edition of the Link I will try to give a brief overview of the work which the Parish Council have undertaken on your behalf during the last financial year.

Our first major achievement is, of course, the work of drainage replacement in Coronation Road and Spruce Lane which, at the time of writing (mid-April) is scheduled for completion at the end of the month. Disruption to householders along the route of the repairs have been kept to a minimum and has been helped by the fact that parking has been available at the village hall. The next big project promised to us, after years of determined persuasion by your Council, is the refurbishment of the drainage system along Abbey Road and Carr Road, including a storm reservoir/lagoon at the Thornton Lane Sewage works. Anglian Water originally advised that this work would begin in April/May this year to tie-in with the Coronation Road repairs and we shall not hesitate to chase them about a start date.

Regrettably, so far the Ulceby Road Safety Group have not been successful in establishing a 7.5 tonnes weight limit through the village although they were able to arrange a temporary diversion route through Habrough and Brocklesby Park for the recent repairs to the A180 carriageway. We shall do all we can to support them. We have been advised by NLC Councillors that the Call Connect bus service is being replaced with a more efficient form of transport support but, as yet, we do not have the full details. Our Parish Council representative on the NATS Committee advises us on safety and

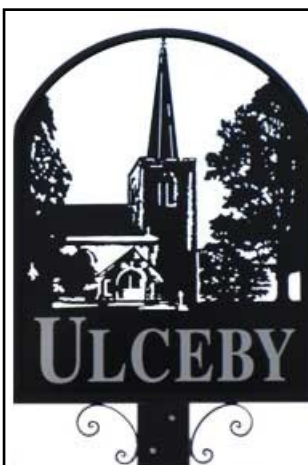
security issues in the village and suggests that particular care is taken by residents in securely locking sheds, garages, etc., and taking care with garden ornaments and furniture which seem currently to be particularly attractive to thieves!

In January, a planning application to build 90 new properties at the end of Station Road met with vociferous objections by more than 30 residents and, following a full and frank discussion, your Councillors unanimously voted to object to the application.

Because of judicious management of the finances, we were able to avoid increasing the precept for the current year of 2019/20 and we will continue to support our local charities, together with the British Legion and the Lives group. We have successfully applied for a grant of £450. towards the cost of planting winter bedding and this Spring will see established flower beds replanted. We have purchased a new seat opposite the Co-Op store and a new dog bin for Brocklesby Road. Arrangements are in hand to purchase a new salt bin for Friars Gate before next winter.

Finally, we welcome three new Councillors who have joined our group, replacing those who have recently resigned and I would reiterate my previous comments to you that all of your Parish Councillors give freely of their time for the benefit of you and our village, and I feel privileged to be part of this caring group.

PARKING ON THE HIGHWAY

Some people are parking vehicles on the road, preventing residents getting in and out of their drives and also causing inconvenience to other road users.

To make sure you don't cause problems:

Do not park:

on a footway or verge
where the kerb has been lowered
within 10 metres of a junction
where it will obstruct other road users
at night: facing oncoming traffic
without lights on roads
where the speed limit is
more than 30mph
without lights if your vehicle
weighs more than 1,525kg
unladen (ie 30cwt approx)

Tips on safe Parking

The highway is for the free flow and passage of moving vehicles.

If you park on the road:

Do it correctly, with all wheels on the roadway;

Do not inconvenience other road and footway users.

If you have a driveway, please use it

Renovation Update
