ULCEBY PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S REPORT MAY – JULY 2019

Currently the Ulceby Road Safety Group have been unsuccessful in their attempts to obtain a weight restriction through the village, however, with support from our North Lincs Councillors, letters have been written by the Transport Division to a dozen local hauliers, requesting their co-operation in limiting the speed of lorries along the A1077. It has also been agreed that the flashing speed limit signs will be retained and that the 30mph limit will be extended throughout the whole village, to include Ulceby Skitter. It will also be extended along Brocklesby Road to the limit of the street lighting boundary there.

The increase in air pollution in the village, caused by heavy goods vehicles, was an important consideration by NLC when refusing permission to the Developer to build the proposed 90 properties at the end of Station Road. Many further discussions are under way regarding road safety and, although progress may appear slow, the Safety Group continue to work tirelessly in their efforts to improve safety in our village. Our NATs representative has obtained agreement for the installation of temporary 'golden rivers' along Station Road to monitor speeding motorists and this information will be used to help to determine future action to be taken by the Authorities.

A request to grant planning permission for a four-property development behind the Fox Inn was objected to by the Parish Council on the grounds that the proposed entrance and exit (through the pub car park), the subsequent difficulty accessing the pub storage facilities, together with an overall increase in the current heavy flow of traffic through Front Street, all presented safety issues.



Again, for safety reasons, Keigar Homes are to be asked, where possible, to avoid deliveries to their development at the rear of Church Lane at school starting and finishing times. In the interest of children's safety, The Parish Council have agreed to fund the refurbishment of the surface of the play area at the Village Hall.

Two new road signs to replace those broken – one at the entrance to Church Lane and one at Model Farm Lane – are on order and, additionally, a request to NLC to erect 20 mph signs in Church Lane will be made. Complaints regarding the quality of the grass mowing in the village, currently undertaken by NLC, have been received. This service may become the responsibility of the Parish Council in 2020 when a more diligent approach to the mowing will be the norm. It was agreed that a fixed flower ring on the village signpost at West End would be purchased to replace the flower troughs there which have been moved, successfully, to Halmshaw's corner.

In conclusion, may we request that wherever garden hedges front on pavements throughout the village, that, in the interests of pedestrian and wheelchair users' safety, these are trimmed tightly back.



Renovation Update

We are delighted to report that the installation of the heating is now complete! This means that we can now offer Services, events and activities in a really warm atmosphere. We have successfully applied to Wren (Communities Foundation) for a grant towards the installation of new lighting and wiring to be installed in the near future. Included in the original Heritage Lottery Grant was a specific sum to be used towards the display of items of local historical interest and, in this regard a supplier based in Thirsk, was approached and provided quotations for the making and installation of first-class bespoke church furniture. Consequently, when the flooring beneath the removed pews in the North and South aisles is made good after the heating installation, an order will be placed with this company for furniture of this kind.

You will be aware of the historical investigations being carried out at Church under the terms of the Heritage Lottery grant and although these are not yet complete, it has already been established that the pew ends down the centre aisle are from the 14th century and the rood screen at the forward entrance to the vestry originates from Thornton Abbey and is dated towards the end of the 15th century. All of this type of information will be collated and printed in a full Church booklet at the end of the project.

Art Project and Exhibition

Following the resumption and completion of the various art projects arrangements were made to hold an Art Sale and Exhibition in Church on Saturday and Sunday, 13th and 14th July. We are delighted to report that this, our first Exhibition and Show, was extremely successful with 30 entrants of all ages from throughout the local area, submitting over 150 pieces of fantastic work across all mediums. We estimate that throughout the Exhibition more than 150 people attended, resulting in an increase of funds of £618. Our thanks go to Ulceby Co-op, Morrisons of Laceby and Tesco of Barton, all of whom supported us by the provision of refreshments. Other projects are in the pipeline!!





One warm August evening my friend rang me to say that I was joining her on an off road mountain bike ride! Now this was something I'd never done before. So I dragged my ageing bike out of the shed and dusted off the dust and cobwebs, loaded it into her car and drove to the meeting point.
