ULCEBY PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S AUTUMN REPORT AUGUST - OCTOBER 2019

During this last three months extensive consultations have taken place between the Ulceby Road Safety Group, our 3 Ward Councillors and various NLC Officers, regarding the village traffic difficulties. These have resulted in ClIr Hannigan (NLC) having written to the Minister of Transport regarding dissatisfaction with both the DRUE (Diversion Route for Unplanned Events) Consultations and the lack of consideration given to emergency vehicle access to Ulceby during these road blockages. ClIr Hannigan has also requested an independent review of the Highways England decision process which affects these discussions. It has, however, been agreed that the exit at the Truck Stop will be reconfigured, encouraging drivers of HGV's to turn right rather than left, thus avoiding the village when leaving. The illuminated speed indicator at West End has been moved to the Village Hall area where it is considered to be more effective and whilst overall, some progress has been made with road safety in the village, there is still a long way to go.

Despite numerous objections from the Parish Council (and supported by our 3 NLC Ward Councillors) regarding the proposed development of 90 properties on land at the east end of Station Road, the Developer has lodged an Appeal against these objections and, at the time of writing, we are awaiting news of the outcome.

Some cutting back and maintenance of village footpaths has been undertaken by NLC and our Ward Councillors have agreed to ensure that the drains in Abbey Road are jetted in an attempt to reduce the odour there.


Chairman's Report Continued from page 1

The seat outside the old school on Church Lane will need to be relocated as the Keigar development in Church Lane progresses, and Keigar have agreed to relocate this seat to the crossroads in Carr Road. Quotes for the repainting of all the village seats, plus the war memorial, are being obtained.

A sub-committee of the Parish Council has been formed to investigate the possible establishment of allotments and an environmental area on the field owned by NLC at the rear of properties on Station Road. The possible use of any S106 monies (received from developers when building in the village) was discussed, with various recreational ideas being put forward for further consideration.

At our September meeting, our NATs Councillor reported a number of attempted village burglaries, with Cllr Hannigan advising that the would-be thief has been arrested, tagged and released on bail. Anti-social behaviour was again an issue in the Coronation Road district and reports received that the 'scrap metal man' has revisited Ulceby, resulting in a number of items in gardens in Abbey Road having been stolen. I hope you can see from the foregoing that the Parish Council continue to work tirelessly for the betterment of our village.

'We are top of the league, say we are top of the league!'

Indeed, what a whirlwind start to the season the lads have had. At the time of writing, seven games played, six victories and just one solitary defeat to Ashby FC which came in the last minute of the game! Made even more frustrating that we really should have been out of sight. Heartbreaking.
