ULCEBY PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S ANNUAL REPORT APRIL 2019 - MARCH 2020

I will attempt an overview of the last year, which in the present difficult circumstances of the lock-down caused by the Corona Virus, has meant that we were not able to hold all of our scheduled meetings.

The refurbishment of the drainage system along Abbey Road and Carr Road, including a storm reservoir/lagoon at the Thornton Lane Sewage works is nearing completion after a long delay caused by the huge amount of rainfall during the autumn. When complete, Abbey Road will be repaired and resurfaced.

The Parish Council have continued their support of the Ulceby Road Safety Group in their endeavours to improve road safety through the village, resulting in an extension along Station Road of the 30 mph limit to just beyond the railway crossing. The same procedure has been applied through to the limit of the end of the street lighting on Brocklesby Road, after which a new limit of 50 mph for a further mile or so has been established. This stretch of road has seen two fatalities in recent years, plus a horrendous bicycle and car collision.

Members of the Parish Council continue to work hard on behalf of Ulceby residents, with representation on the NATS Committee advising on village safety and security issues, making visits to and offering suggestions for the possible design and layout of the proposed allotment/environmental area behind Station Road,



updating the village Emergency Plan and attendance at the Appeal hearing of the proposed 90 new-build properties in Station Road. Regrettably, as far as your Parish Council is concerned, the outcome was successful for the Developer and, therefore, at some time in the future, building at the far end of Station Road will begin.

Regular concerns voiced by residents, e.g. inconsiderate vehicle parking, encroaching hedgerows, necessary pavement and road repairs, etc., continue to be dealt with by the Parish Council and, following a suggestion from residents, it is hoped to arrange for the erection of an illuminated Christmas tree at the village entrance this December. We shall also continue our annual support of various charitable organisations. Planting of the spring and winter bedding continues and, additionally, the Parish Council have now taken responsibility for the grass mowing within the 30 mph limit of the village during the summer of 2020. We hope, by so doing, to improve the overall appearance of the grass verges.

Lastly, I wish to repeat my previous comments that thanks should be afforded to the members of the Parish Council who continue to work diligently and give freely of their time for all Ulceby residents and it is really rewarding to be part of this very supportive community group.

Criminals are exploiting the COVID-19 pandemic to try and get their hands on your money and personal information. To date, Action Fraud has received reports from 2,378 victims of Coronavirus-related scams, with the total losses reaching over £7 million.

Coronavirus Track & Trace Scams Advice

Be aware of a growing trend of criminals taking advantage of the current Covid-19 crisis to defraud innocent people, including the new NHS Test and Trace service. This service has been introduced to allow the NHS to trace the spread of the virus, isolate new infections and give early warning if the virus is increasing again, and plays an important role in the fight against coronavirus and it's vital the public have confidence and trust in the service. However, we understand the concerns people have about the opportunity for criminals to commit scams, as scammers are now making phone calls, sending texts and emails pretending to be from NHS Test and Trace in order to obtain your personal

Advice on how to identify a genuine contact tracer from a scammer.

Contact tracers will **only call you from the number 0300 013 5000**. Anyone who does not wish to talk over the phone can request the NHS Test and Trace service to send an email or text instead, inviting them to log into the web-based service. All text or emails sent by NHS Test and Trace will ask people to sign into the contact tracing website and will provide you with a unique reference number. We would advise people to **type the web address** <u>https://contact-tracing.phe.gov.uk</u> **directly into their browser**, followed by the unique reference number given to you, rather than clicking on any link provided in the message.

Genuine NHS contact tracers will:

- -call you from 0300 013 5000
- -send you text messages from 'NHS'
- -ask you to sign into the NHS test and trace contact-tracing website
- -ask for your full name and date of birth to confirm your identity, and postcode to offer support while self-isolating
- -ask about the coronavirus symptoms you have been experiencing
- -ask you to provide the name, telephone number and/or email address of anyone you have had close contact with in the two days prior to your symptoms starting
- -ask if anyone you have been in contact with is under 18 or lives outside of England.

Contact tracers will never:

-ask you to dial a premium rate number to speak to them (for example, those starting 09 or 087)

-ask you to make any form of payment or purchase a product of any kind -ask for any details about your bank account

-ask for your social media identities or login details, or those of your contacts

-ask you for any passwords or PINs, or ask you to set up any passwords or PINs over the phone

-disclose any of your personal or medical information to your contacts

- -provide medical advice on the treatment of any potential coronavirus symptoms
- -ask you to download any software to your PC or ask you to hand over control of your PC, smartphone or tablet to anyone else
- -ask you to access any website that does not belong to the government or NHS

If you or somebody you know has been caught out by a scam or fraud contact Action Fraud on 0300 123 2040 or visit the Action Fraud website at https:// www.actionfraud.police.uk. If you need advice on anything else, please contact the Citizens Advice Consumer Helpline 0344 411 1444

You will only ever be called from the number 0300 013 5000, or you will be texted from "NHS".

There are some simple steps you can take that will protect you from the other most common scams.

1 - Watch out for scam messages

Your bank, or other official organisations, won't ask you to share personal information over email or text. If you receive an email you're not quite sure about, forward it to the Suspicious Email Reporting Service (SERS): report@phishing.gov.uk

2 - Shopping online

If you're making a purchase from a company or person you don't know and trust. carry out some research first, for example, by checking to see if others have used the site and what their experience was. If you decide to go ahead with the purchase, use a credit card if you have one, other payment providers may not provide the same protection.

3 - Unsolicited calls and browser pop-ups offering tech support

Never install any software, or grant remote access to your computer, as a result of a cold call. Remember, legitimate organisations would never contact you out of the blue to ask for financial details such as your PIN or full banking password.

LIFE DURING LOCKDOWN

This has been a stressful time for many, especially those people shielding and unable to leave their home. However the appearance of the village has been improved with many people tending their gardens, replacing fences, painting fences and gates. The initial panic buying of a few, which left frustratingly empty shelves for the rest just wanting to do their normal shop, has passed. Many working from home have saved on time and cost by not having to travel to work, but suffered the stress of the local slow and intermittent internet connections. Most school children have had to stay at home, draw rainbows and do the daily work sent by the school on their home computers, while their parents have had to adopt the role of teachers. Those undertaking daily walks have been able to explore footpaths in the local countryside, and seen the change of seasons from Spring to Summer, the brown fields turning green as the farmers' crop seed managed to germinate and grow - despite the very dry weather initially. All local groups have had to stop, but will hopefully resume before too long, even if they are somewhat restricted by social distancing. And throughout all this, we have to thank the key workers for carrying out their duties regardless of putting themselves at risk, and the support and kindness that's been shown from neighbours and other volunteers.



WHERE DOES YOUR MONEY GO?

Of the amount each household pays to North Lincolnshire Council in Council Tax, approximately £17 is passed to Ulceby Parish Council in the precept. A proportion of this is spent on essential items, and the remainder is spent locally to benefit the village, as the Parish Council thinks fit. Some is used to improve the appearance of the village, such as flower displays and grass cutting around the church and playing field, and some to support local groups and organisations. If you are involved in such a group which is in need of funding, or are interested in setting up a new group and would like to apply for some financial assistance, there is an application form available from the website www.ulceby.net, or from Karen Pickering, the Clerk to the Council.

The precept was set at £15,000 for 2019/20, and this was boosted by a North Lincolnshire Council precept grant of £1,192. We have tried to keep it as low as possible for a number of years, but due to rising costs it was felt necessary to increase it to £18,000 for the current year. In addition, some income is received from the cost of advertising in this newsletter, which more than covers the cost of its printing. For your information, the chart below gives a breakdown of how the precept was spent in 2019/20.

with dementia with volunteers who enable them to continue doing something they love.

Meanwhile, we work alongside many other agencies, such as Age UK, and can signpost and refer to agencies you may benefit from.

Many people are unaware that those with a diagnosis of dementia are entitled to a blue disability badge or an attendance allowance ranging from £60 to £90 per week.

This is regardless of your financial circumstances, and our friendly team can help you to apply for this benefit. We also offer a free service (you just pay the court registration fee) to set up Lasting Power of Attorney if that is something you have thought about.

All these services are offered nationally, including your local Alzheimer's Society's office.

As well as accessing all the support mentioned above, North Lincolnshire have three memory cafes running where staff would greet you with a warm welcome.

If you are a carer of a person with dementia you can either come on your own or bring the person with dementia with you.

It's an informal, friendly atmosphere where you get to meet others experiencing similar issues to yourself, as well as supportive staff and volunteers.

We have various activities on offer and listen to what people say they want to see at the session. This, of course, includes tea, coffee and biscuits! We also run a Singing For The Brain group which has proved to be extremely popular – either come along and clean out those vocal pipes or sit back and listen with a cuppa.



family members and close friends. There are an estimated 850,000 people in the UK living with dementia. But what does it mean to have this condition?

confused much of the time, and even struggling to recognise

your life - forgetting how to perform simple tasks, feeling

Dementia is the umbrella term that describes various brain disorders such as Alzheimer's disease, Vascular Dementia and Dementia with Lewy Bodies to name but a few, that result in loss of brain function.

Symptoms often include memory loss, confusion, problems in understanding and communication difficulties.

Living with dementia or caring for somebody who has the condition can often feel isolating and lonely, including feelings of sadness, frustration and anger. A lady once described her husband to me as a sandcastle and dementia as the sea.

"Each time the tide comes in and goes back out, it takes away a little bit of him with it." she explained.

In the current testing times, we are living in with COVID-19 resulting in a national lockdown, these feelings are intensified, leaving people without the support they perhaps were once used to, such as visits from family members or relying on attending groups for support.

The symptoms of dementia are progressive and, eventually, terminal. However, as daunting as this may sound, we at the Alzheimer's Society believe people can live well with dementia with the right support.
