ULCEBY PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

WINTER UPDATE – FEBRUARY AND MARCH 2021

We continue with our Zoom meetings each month, thanks to the Covid virus! At the January meeting, after detailed discussion, and a commitment that when further funds allowed an adult gym trail could be erected on their grounds, it was agreed that the Parish Council would support the Village Hall in their funding of a new playground to the sum of £13,548.60. This was the amount outstanding after their successful grant applications and it was hoped the work would start in May. This \$106 money from the Parish Council had been accrued from recent village developments.

A larger chemical dosing tank has been erected at the pumping station in Thornton Lane which should avoid odours in Abbey Road; the resurfacing of this the road will take place in the coming Spring/Summer. A review of Drainage and Water Management in NLC including previous village flooding, was taking place. A contract to resurface Croxton Road has been awarded and this work will start in the new Financial Year. Parking of HGV vehicles in the Co-op delivery layby are still causing problems. Enforcement officers and the traffic police have been asked to monitor the layby and Coun Hannigan will ensure larger prohibitive signage is displayed there. The Highways Team are researching the possible siting of a Pedestrian Crossing at the existing school crossing site and NLC are undertaking a full risk assessment and freight strategy in Ulceby and Goxhill.

URSG reported that the previous DREW arrangements for diverting one lane of traffic away from the village during A180 closures has been withdrawn and the alternative route offered by NELC via Stallingborough

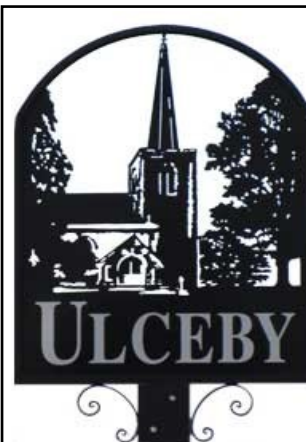
Chairman's Report Continued from page 1

and Riby and eventually rejoining the A180, did not seem satisfactory. A review meeting of the DREW arrangements had previously been arranged for March, when URSG will raise this item again. The Safer Roads Humber would resume their support of the village Community Speed Watch monitoring following release from the current lock-down and the three identified sites at Skitter Hill, along Station Road and at Brocklesby Road would continue. Following lengthy discussion, it was agreed that the Clerk should obtain the costs and possible grants available for purchasing and installing 2 additional Radar Speed Signs, one of which would be sited on Brocklesby Road. The information these modern signs recorded can be downloaded and used as evidence of the need for further village road safety measures.

When setting the 2021/22 precept, it was unanimously agreed that there should be no increase in the current annual figure of £18,000 and the Parish Council would accept the community partnership funding. The Community grant of £250 for Spring in Bloom would be used to purchase and plant up two further baskets for attachment to the village signs at Brocklesby Road and Skitter to match the existing sign at West End. The rerouting of the Humber Flyer through the village appears to be working well, with two additional stops arranged along Front Street, in addition to the original stop at West End. Signs showing designated boarding and alighting points will be established and villagers are urged, following lock-down release, to use this Service wherever possible in order to ensure its' continuation.

Compiling of the village Emergency Plan was continuing by the Clerk with an appeal for emergency volunteers in this edition of the Link. Following a lengthy discussion, the Clerk was also asked to make all the necessary enquiries, including obtaining possible grants and agency costs, towards establishing a Neighbourhood Plan for Ulceby. When these details were to hand the adoption of such a Plan would be discussed and decided.

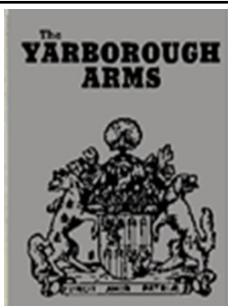

ULCEBY PLAY PARK

Ulceby Village Association would like to thank everyone who supported our play park project. We are pleased to say that full funding has been secured and we are entering the final part of our journey.

Great thanks to our wonderful community for taking part in any activities which supported the project, Ulceby Parish Council with Section 106 funding, the SSE Sustainable Development Fund and FCC Community Action Fund.

All being well, Ulceby will see a new park for the children before the year is over. You will find more regular updates when they arrive, simply follow us on our facebook page.

WHAT IS SECTION 106 FUNDING?

When building developments in excess of 9 properties are built, the builders have to make a contribution to improvements in the local area - this is called Section 106 money.

With the larger developments, North Lincolnshire Council often decide where this money should be spent.

However, in the case of the smaller developments recently built, and under construction in the village, the builder Keigar Homes Ltd has stipulated that the related S106 money should be made available Ulceby Parish Council to utilise it for outdoor recreation/play to benefit the residents of Ulceby. As the Ulceby Parish Council does not own any land to be able to site such equipment, it is able to purchase equipment to be sited on land at Ulceby Village Hall and Playing Field, without using any of the precept. A few years ago, a wall was purchased and constructed behind the hall, which has a target goal for kicking footballs at, and a netball/basket ball hoop for practice. This has proved very popular, as could be seen from the erosion of the soil in front of it, which had to be repaired last year. The more recent builds in the village have released money which Ulceby Parish Council has allocated to the new play park project, to provide the remaining funding required for that to enable that to proceed.

WATCH OUT FOR SCAMS!

There are some simple steps you can take that will protect you from the most common scams.

1 - Watch out for scam messages

Your bank, or other official organisations, won't ask you to share personal information over email or text. If you receive an email you're not quite sure about, forward it to the Suspicious Email Reporting Service (SERS): report@phishing.gov.uk

2 - Shopping online

If you're making a purchase from a company or person you don't know and trust, carry out some research first, for example, by checking to see if others have used the site and what their experience was. If you decide to go ahead with the purchase, use a credit card if you have one, other payment providers may not provide the same protection.

3 - Unsolicited calls and browser pop-ups offering tech support

Never install any software, or grant remote access to your computer, as a result of a cold call. Remember, legitimate organisations would never contact you out of the blue to ask for financial details such as your PIN or full banking

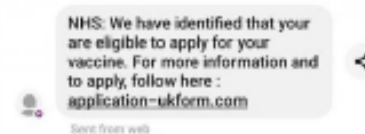

COVID-19 Vaccine Scam

We have been made aware of a new text message scam that is being circulated. A message is sent seemingly from the NHS saying that you are now eligible to apply for the new vaccine and to click on the link to apply. If clicked the link will take you to a fake NHS webpage that asks for your personal details. If you receive the below text please **DO NOT** click on the link.

- **DO NOT** click on links in unknown texts - always check it first.
- **NEVER** give out your personal details.
- Cold calls regarding the vaccine are also beginning to take place.



Top 4 text message scams:

1. Fake URL links claiming to link to GOV.UK website to claim supposed COVID-19 related payment.
2. Lockdown fines suggesting you have breached lockdown.
3. Offers of health supplements that will prevent you becoming infected.
4. Financial support offers that appear to be from your bank.

CRIME PREVENTION ADVICE

Avoiding Rogue Traders

- **Be cautious** -if a trader knocks at your door, **do not** agree to on the spot house repairs without taking advice. Say 'no thank you' and close the door.
- **Be wary of special offers.** They will use tactics such as 'I am only in your area today and would need to do the work now'.
- **Do not believe** when told that guttering, roofing, gardening or paving work is in need of urgent repair – this may cause you to panic and allow the work to take place.
- **Do not allow anyone to pressure you** into agreeing to have work carried out.
- **Do not make snap decisions.** If you feel that any work needs carrying out on your property, take time to talk to family or neighbours before you make a decision.
- **Don't ever go to a bank or cash point with a trader** - legitimate traders would never do this!

Reporting a Rogue Trader

If you have had an experience with a rogue trader, please report it by telephoning 101.

For live incidents where the rogue trader is still at the property, or is due to return, contact the **police on 999**. The police have a protocol for dealing with these incidents and welcome your contact.

MAKE ULCEBY A MORE PLEASANT PLACE TO LIVE IN PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG



Dog faeces are:-

1. Dangerous because they may contain the eggs of a parasite (the roundworm toxocara canis) that can cause blindness and other health problems, especially in young children.
The eggs may be ingested when passed to the mouth by the hands - this can occur not only through contact with dogs but also other inanimate objects including the wheels of toys and the soles of shoes or contaminated soil or carpets.
2. Dangerous because they are a slipping hazard to people using the footpath.
3. Unpleasantly Smelly and a Health Hazard, when picked up on shoes or the wheels of pushchairs and wheelchairs and trampled into the carpets of innocent people's homes.

If you fail to clean up after your dog you can be issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice, or if the case goes to court, a fine of up to £1,000. Being unaware that the dog has fouled, or not having a suitable means of removing the faeces is not a reasonable excuse for failing to clean up after your dog.

If you see any offenders – please report them
