

ULCEBY PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S ANNUAL REPORT May - July 2021

May saw us able to resume face-to-face Parish Council meetings.

The Public Footpath sign, a replacement dog waste bin and the siting of a replacement seat, all in the area of the recently developed old school site, is ongoing. Financial support for a wildlife habitat project in the area of the village hall pond was agreed and we are grateful to all the residents who took part in the recent 'spring clean' of hedges and paths in the village as part of the preparations for the Best Kept Village competition. NLC have advised that they propose remedial work in the area of the quarry underpass in order to make this area accessible throughout the year. Currently it is prone to severe winter flooding. Requests have been made to NLC to scrape back some pavements and grass cutting throughout the village, where it is the responsibility of the Parish Council, will be subject to a review. The Village Hall's request for financial assistance towards meeting the cost of grass cutting was agreed.

During this period we continued our support of the Ulceby Road Safety Group when, via Zoom and Microsoft Teams facilities, URSG and some members of the Parish Council were invited to take part in discussions with NLC Officers on two major topics – a Freight Strategy and a Route Assessment discussion. Regrettably, these meetings did not offer any resolutions to the problems of traffic through Ulceby; however, URSG will continue to press the case for a 7.5 cwt weight limit as a first step towards greater safety and the Parish Council will press NLC for a copy of the Freight Survey which was promised to us many weeks ago. A grant for the installation of two more comprehensive radar speed signs has been submitted to NLC and we await their reply. Information about the April



footfall count at the crossroads in relation to the possible siting of a pedestrian crossing is also awaited. With the lifting of Covid restrictions, the community speed watch initiative has resumed with a number of motorists being shown to have exceeded the village speed limit, although there are limitations as to where they are permitted to operate. NLC will be approached to consider expediting making the additional speed calming road markings, promised to us several months ago.

A face-to-face meeting with an Officer from NLC to assess the need for a Neighbourhood Plan for Ulceby is to be arranged and we have extended an invitation to the group assisting with the Emergency Plan to address the Parish Council regarding the next steps. NLC have provisionally agreed to grant the Parish Council a 25-year lease on the land behind Station Road and to ensure we incorporate as many suggestions for its' use as possible (e.g. siting a gym trail, allotments, contemplation garden, wildflower meadow, benches etc), all of which have been approved by the Estates Officer, it has been agreed to seek to employ a professional designer to incorporate these suggestions before final approval for the layout is sought from NLC and details of a Lease duly agreed. Our NATS representative reported that the topic dominating the current round of meetings is that of fly tipping and urgent steps are being taken to eradicate this dreadful problem.

We have unfortunately received the resignation of 2 parish councillors, and advertisements will shortly be placed to fill their vacancies. Watch the notice board or website for details.



Work begins on new Children's play park in Ulceby

Building work is under way to create a new play park for children in Ulceby, North Lincolnshire.

The Ulceby village play park project is a step closer now that the construction team have arrived and the old equipment is due to be taken out at the site on Spruce Lane.

The project, which is being largely funded by a £70,000 grant from FCC Communities Foundation, will provide all new play equipment, including a multi-gym, trim trail, inclusive roundabout, swings and bouncers once it is open later this year.

Karen Denton, Trustee of Ulceby Village Association, project manager of the new play park is excited that the project is starting to take shape.

She says: "It's great to see our vision for this vital community facility moving closer to reality. We are extremely grateful for the funding FCC Communities Foundation has given us and we're looking forward to opening it to the public."

FCC Communities Foundation is a not-for-profit business that awards grants for community projects through the Landfill Communities Fund.

Richard Smith, FCC Communities Foundation senior grant manager, says: "It's always nice to see something we have funded start to take shape. We're delighted to be supporting the play area improvement in Ulceby and look forward to it benefitting families and children for many years to come."

Valkyrie Wilderness Workshops



Valkyrie Wilderness Workshops, based in Keelby, was founded in 2020 by Army Veteran Steve Baxter



with the aim of providing support to Armed Forces Veterans and others in the community struggling with mental health issues, isolation or addiction. Participants take part in a variety of activities at our rural basecamp, 'Valhalla', and through these can choose to share their problems with others and gain peer support. Our support programmes are free of charge to those who need them.

The activities we regularly undertake include axe & knife throwing, wood tattooing, woodworking and archery. Participants in our recent projects have also undertaken groundwork and construction on the site. Our future plans involve a full renovation of a barn which forms part of the site into a Viking-themed indoor space. This project will be led by local interior designer Rob Fawcett, who has recently featured on BBC2's Saved and Remade series. People joining our Wilderness Wellbeing Workshops will have the opportunity to be involved in this work if they wish, learning new skills from Rob. We are also developing a pond on site for fishing, which we hope to have completed in the next few months, and plans are also in place for opening a Men in Sheds Group in the near future. Our open workshops will commence in June and take place every Tuesday, and are part funded by a grant from the National Lottery Community Fund.

Once a month we run weekend camps for Armed Forces Veterans, supporting those who are experiencing mental health difficulties or personal problems relating to their service. Participants undertake a day of activities before sitting down around the campfire in the evening to share their experiences. For 2021 we are inviting local businesses to sponsor our camps, or individuals to sponsor a Veteran's place on one of our camps.

To help fund our work we run open Axe & Knife Throwing sessions on Wednesdays 6pm-8pm and Saturdays 10am-12pm. Sessions cost £15 for adults and £10 for 12-16s. Our axe range is also available for private bookings for groups of over 8 people. Tips on safe Parking

Humberside Police can prosecute for dangerous or unnecessary obstruction - BE WARNED!

Some people are parking vehicles on the road, preventing residents getting in and out of their drives and also causing inconvenience to other road users.

To make sure you don't cause problems:

Do not park:

on a footway or verge where the kerb has been lowered within 10 metres of a junction where it will obstruct other road users

at night: facing oncoming traffic without lights on roads where the speed limit is more than 30mph without lights if your vehicle weighs more than 1,525kg unladen (ie 30cwt approx)
