ULCEBY PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN'S UPDATE

November 2021 – January 2022

At the November meeting, D Lofts of NLC explained in some detail the objectives of a Neighbourhood Plan and its various stages of implementation. Following discussion, the Parish Council agreed that they would consider the establishment of such a plan in the forthcoming months. Inconsiderate parking in Hallcroft was discussed and Cllr Hannigan would pursue this matter. Several residents who objected to the signage and external chimney outlet of the proposed Indian restaurant on the site of the old Co-op attended the meeting to voice their concerns. It was agreed that the Parish Council would object to the proposed signage, requesting something more in keeping with a village status and also request further clarification on the specification and positioning of the extractor chimney flue.

On matters of road safety, it was reported in January that the community speed watch scheme had recorded that 15% of vehicles travelling through the village are doing so at speeds in excess of 30 mph. A new radar activated speed sign has been erected on Brocklesby Road and it is hoped that NLC will have received, and can offer, a copy of the long-promised Freight Report shortly. The Road Safety group tabled a graph showing the number of HGVs using the road through Ulceby during week commencing 10 January which had logged that on Thursday 13th, more than 500 of these had been recorded. NLC Councillors reported that the Highways Division are actively seeking a solution to the problem of HGVs and confirmed that the new pedestrian crossing on High Street would be established during the forthcoming financial year. Details of a '20 is Plenty' speed reduction initiative would be circulated to all Councillors by the Safety Group.


The response to requests for volunteers to help with the community garden proposed for the land behind the bungalows in Station Road has been very poor, however the Clerk has obtained the name and details of a Specialist planner experienced in establishing such a community space whose help will be sought. The preparation of a village Emergency Plan is still being pursued and, again, help is being sought with this from a practiced planner. The Village Hall Committee is planning a celebration for the Jubilee weekend on Saturday 4th June, and the Parish Council is hoping to support them financially. The pavement at West End requires scraping back and repairs to the original pavements in Hallcroft are obvious. Following discussion, the precept figure for 2022/23 was set at £20.000 to take account of intended village improvements - a small increase on the previous year, but this will be absorbed by the cost being spread over the additional new houses in the village.

DEFIBRILLATOR AT ULCEBY VILLAGE HALL AND HOW TO USE IT



There has been a lot in the news recently about defibrillators, and how the lives of people have been saved by their use. In case you are not already aware, there is a community defibrillator at Ulceby Village Hall located on the front wall at the right-hand end, which is accessible 24/7 to anyone in the vicinity who requires it in an emergency, meaning more lives could be saved.

After a cardiac arrest every minute without CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) and defibrillation reduces someone's chance of survival by 10 per cent.

Defibrillators are very easy to use. If you come across someone who is not breathing or breathing erratically, the most important thing is to call 999 and start CPR. If you're on your own, don't interrupt the CPR to go and get a defibrillator. Find someone else to get it.

When they are at the unit, there are clear instructions on it to follow - dial 999, give the number on the unit, and they will be given a code to be able to open the unit and get the defibrillator out, which must be taken to the location of the emergency as quickly as possible. Then all you have to do is follow the spoken instructions given by the machine. You don't need training to use one.

Once in position, the defibrillator detects the heart's rhythm. It won't deliver a shock unless one is needed. They are simple and safe to use.
