Ulceby Parish Council CHAIRMAN'S ANNUAL REPORT April 2021 – March 2022

Throughout all the trials of the various lock-downs during this period, the Parish Council continued to hold their scheduled meetings but it was a relief to us all when, finally, we could actually see each other to discuss the various topics, without the need to be 'masked up'. However, there is no doubt that the pandemic has adversely affected our ability, and that of North Lincs Council, to fulfil the projects and tasks which we have been able to complete. Three projects which have still been pursued are the establishment of a community garden on the land behind the properties on Station Road, the preparation of a village Emergency Plan and the siting of a pedestrian crossing, although the actual positioning of the crossing at the central village junction is still under discussion.

We have also established the practice of siting a lighted Christmas tree in the War Memorial enclosure and have continued the verge grass cutting and flower display planters throughout the village. Additionally, to mark the Jubilee we have decided to site two 'waterfall' design planters within the confines of the Memorial to supplement the planters already there. The Ulceby Road Safety Group have continued their speed watch programme and an additional speed sign has been sited on Brocklesby Road. The preparation of a Freight Report from NLC is still awaited but we have been advised that when it is received, regretfully, it still may not benefit our traffic difficulties. The URSG continue, with support from the Parish Council, their pursuit of a 7.5 ton weight limit through the village.







Unfortunately a number of the supporting stakes and protective covers for the saplings have been removed by individuals who felt it a good idea to throw them into the pond, and some of the saplings themselves have disappeared, but hopefully those that still remain will be allowed to grow bigger and enhance the appearance of the area and benefit the wildlife. There are some cherry, elder and rowan trees that will blossom in the spring, and provide berries for the birds in summer and autumn.
