

### **Ulceby Parish Council** CHAIRMAN'S UPDATE

April – July 2022

In April the Parish Council voted unanimously to object to the building of a solar panel farm at the old Zulu Farm in Carr Road, citing 11 major rejections. At the same meeting the Humber Low Carbon Pipeline was discussed when it was agreed that prior to this pipeline being established, it was necessary that a robust traffic management plan should be put in place which prevents vehicles for this project from travelling through Ulceby. The meeting also felt that both our village and the pipeline would be better served if it was located further West, away from Uceby completely.

In June, the building of an additional 27 houses on the site in Station Road where permission already exists to erect 90 dwellings was supported by the Developer, explaining that this addition would increase the number of 2/3 bedroomed properties available and would increase the number of affordable homes from 9 to 12. Five conditions were attached by the Parish Council to this plan, including the siting of a pelican crossing in this area, all construction traffic must use the A180 and avoid the village, and that priority for the affordable homes should be given to residents of Ulceby or close villages. The matter of securing the S106 monies associated with the extra houses has been pursued by the Clerk (with input from Cllr Hannigan) and NLC advised that this money, since it has to be used for recreational purposes, would be for the erection (at the safe location of the Village Hall) of a teenage/adult gym trail.

The NAT's representative reported that the difficulty of fly tipping is an increasing problem. Examination of the Lease from North Lincs Council for the land behind Station Road, which the Parish Council proposed to adapt for allotments/communal garden/etc, was discussed but there were two important clauses which the Parish Council could not agree on. These related to NLC being able to revoke the Lease with only six months' notice to vacate the site.

and also that the Parish Council be liable for any flooding which occurred. This matter will be carried forward to the September meeting when a full attendance by Parish Council members will occur and an agreed decision reached.

In July it was reported that the Ulceby Road Safety group have had a meeting with Inspector Jamie Allen who has promised more police presence in the village and this increased presence had been evident over the last few days. The Community Speed Watch team may be permitted to use locations used by Safer Roads Humber when not in use by them. The siting of the pedestrian crossing at the village centre has been the subject of a full safety audit by NLC of the proposed Parish Council's alternative siting, east of the crossroads. The conclusion of the audit was that, either the crossing was established at the original location to the west of the crossroads, as determined by NLC, or the siting of a crossing would have to be abandoned completely. This resulted in a vote of 7 in favour with 1 abstention, that the pedestrian crossing be established where NLC originally determined, at the west of the crossroads.







#### WHERE DOES YOUR MONEY GO?

Of the amount each household pays to North Lincolnshire Council in Council Tax, approximately £17 is passed to Ulceby Parish Council in the precept. A proportion of this is spent on essential items, and the remainder is spent locally to benefit the village, as the Parish Council thinks fit. Some is used to improve the appearance of the village, such as flower displays and grass cutting around the church and playing field, and some to support local groups and organisations. If you are involved in such a group which is in need of funding, or are interested in setting up a new group and would like to apply for some financial assistance, please contact Karen Pickering, the Clerk to the Council (details on back page).

The precept was set at £18,000 for 2021/22, but it has now been increased to £20,000 for the current year. For your information, the chart below gives a breakdown of how the precept was spent in 2021/22. As well as the precept, payments were received from North Lincolnshire Council for the costs of grass mowing around the village of £4404, and Section 106 money of £13,915 was received from Keigar to pass on to the village hall for the new play equipment.. In addition, some income is received from the cost of advertising in this newsletter, which more than covers the cost of its printing.

The fishing is hit and miss, but it is great to see so many youngsters enjoying the sport. However, please take away your rubbish, it is unsightly. Also the likes of discarded tin lids and hooks give way to expensive vet bills.

Visit the pond at present and get to the waters edge. The smell of fresh water mint is quite something in the heat. The raspberries are all but gone and in their place are the blackberries. Come enjoy, sit a while and fill your wares. We really do have a little oasis in the village.

### Dog care in summer - Advice for dog owners

Never leave dogs in hot cars, conservatories, or outbuildings on a warm day.

Use pet-safe sun cream on exposed parts of your pet's skin to avoid sunburn.

Ensure pets always have access to shade and fresh drinking water.

Give your pet damp towels to lie on or an ice pack wrapped in a towel.

Groom them regularly in warm weather to brush away any dead or excess hair

#### Walking your dog on hot weather

Dogs need exercise, even when it's hot. Walk your dog in the morning or evening when it's cooler to reduce the risk of heatstroke and burning their paws on the pavement. Try the 5-second test - if it's too hot for your hands, it's too hot for paws!

You can also look out for signs of heatstroke - heavy panting and difficulty breathing, excessively drooling, the dog appears lethargic, drowsy or uncoordinated, collapsed or vomiting

If you suspect your dog has the signs of heat stroke you must act quickly.

#### Weight Restriction for Ulceby, Thornton Curtis and Wootton

We are pleased to update you on proposals to secure a weight limit except for access arrangements throughout the above villages. This means that HGV vehicles passing through would be prohibited access, however those delivering to local shops and businesses within the weight limit would still be able to access the area.

Initially the proposed scheme would operate under an experimental order, to ensure the effectiveness of the proposal. The Scheme would be implemented in October/November 2022 for a period of up to 18 months.

We consulted residents on proposals for a weight limit before covid and we received some positive feedback. The next phase of this process includes a consultation with local businesses who may be affected by these changes. Once we have received their comments a formal decision could be taken to implement the experimental order.

Works would include updating a number of the road signs in the villages and on major roads in order to indicate these changes.

We are working on proposals to enable local residents and the enforcement agencies to carry out the appropriate enforcement procedures.

Once we have received the consultation feedback we will be back in touch to confirm the next steps.
