By the time you receive this Newsletter, the long-awaited pedestrian crossing at the centre of the village should have been constructed and, towards the end of November, the eighteen-month trial period of a 7.5 ton weight limit through the village should have been established. This limit should drastically reduce the numbers of HGVs travelling through the village by restricting vehicles to only those with a genuine reason for local delivery and collection. This restriction will be reviewed during the trial period and adjusted if necessary. We have waited many years for the pedestrian crossing and this. together with the weight limit trial are road safety features which the Ulceby Road Safety Group, in conjunction with the Parish Council, have been pursuing for several years. The Clerk advised that permission had also been granted for the Community Speed Watch group to use the entrance to Martins Road as a location for speed checking and, additionally, an NLC representative will visit Ulceby regarding the possible siting of two more speed activated warning signs, in the area of Station Road and beyond the Co-Op store.

Cllr Hannigan is liaising with NLC legal team regarding the 'break' clause in the lease for the land at the rear of Station Road when it was suggested that this 'break' should refer to a period of 5 years for either party. Solicitors acting for the Parish Council will be advised accordingly and more information will be made available as it is received. A suggestion that hanging baskets should be positioned on street lamps in the village was discussed and the Clerk had made extensive enquiries of NLC in this regard. A structural report would be required to ensure the safety of each lamp post, at a prohibitive cost and, additionally, it was felt that the daily watering, with the associated health and safety concerns, made the cost and practicality of this scheme prohibitive.





As you may be aware the Rev Peter Green is no longer the Vicar at St Nicholas' Church as he resigned from the Ministry at the end of July. Christmas Day Communion will be at Thornton Curtis church at 9am


The church is generally unlocked during daylight hours and you are welcome to use the space for private prayer - or just come and enjoy the peace and quiet of this beautiful building.
