#### Ulceby Parish Council CHAIRMAN'S QUARTERLY UPDATE

November 2022 – January 2023

At the November meeting it was agreed that there should be no increase in the precept for the financial year of 2023/24 and the figure of £20,000. will remain. A £20 voucher awarded under the heading of 'Most Improved Village' would be used to purchase further bulbs for planting in September 2023 and the sum of £500 has been awarded from NLC as part of the 'In Bloom' fund. There will be an additional grant to the Parish Council of £250 to be used for expenses occurring through Coronation celebrations.

The trial weight limit through Ulceby began in early November and, following the first two weeks of trialling, the number of HGVs through the village has drastically reduced, with one or two exceptions which are being monitored and will be reported to the Police if this practice continues. Indeed, Ulceby is beginning to return to the sort of village it once was. For further safety, a Road Traffic Order is to be sought to extend the double yellow lines outside Abdal's Restaurant on Spruce Lane, up to the village hall. Indeed, it was suggested at January's meeting that for additional safety, these lines should be extended to the commencement of Station Road. This suggestion will be considered further. The Community Speed Watch team are continuing to log vehicles passing through the village with more than 5000 having been monitored recently. There has been a distinct improvement in thru-village speeding since the Speed Watch team was introduced and more advanced equipment was now a possibility. Vehicles are overtaking in a dangerous manner when leaving the village enroute to the Truck Stop, and vice versa, and appropriate road markings or signs are required to remedy this practice.

Regarding the extension of the ABP and Air Products facilities proposed for the new Immingham Green Energy Terminal, it was agreed that the applicants should be advised to ensure that a robust traffic management plan was in place, that all associated traffic should avoid travelling through Ulceby and the prevailing weight Page 2 Ulceby Parish Link



limit through the village should be emphasised. Following a complaint to NLC, the footpath from the Church to West End has been inspected and agreement reached that the level should be raised and the path upgraded when finances permit. NLC have been advised and have inspected the deep puddle which occurs on one side of the new Pedestrian Crossing following rainfall, and this problem will be rectified in due course. Cllr Clark agreed to request NLC to inspect all the footpaths in the village since some were falling into dangerous disrepair. The poor surface of the road between the Croxton bends and the Singleton Birch site was commented on and NLC Councillors advised that this stretch of road was earmarked for resurfacing in due course.


Further clarification of the lease from North Lincs Council of the land behind Station Road has been received and, after prolonged discussion in January, it was agreed that this project would now be taken forward, with the lease for the land being formally signed. The development of this area would be a long-term project, with monies released from the Parish Council as S106 funds became available, and as interest garnered from residents demonstrated the various facilities which they wished to see developed.




