

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT August – October 2023

Whilst Ulceby didn't win the Best Kept Village competition, we did receive a Highly Commended award, so thank you to all those residents who helped, in any way, to keep our village litter-free and tidy.

The Community Speed Watch team, part of the Ulceby Road Safety Group, are still monitoring vehicle speeds through the village and the areas of most concern are Spruce Lane towards Immingham (14% speed violations - 76 mph max) and on Brocklesby Road (65% recorded speed violations – 85 mph max). Regrettably, we were not successful in our application for a grant towards the purchase of an additional speed sign for the village, and whilst the Give Way sign at the exit to the Truck Stop is guite clearly marked, after discussion at the September meeting, Coun Hannigan offered to speak to NLC officers regarding a review of the speed limit for the area from the roundabout to the Truck Stop in an endeavour to warn motorists about lorries emerging. He would also request the reinstatement of the side-of-road markings in this area.

The double vellow lines in front of Abdal's Restaurant will shortly become a no-loading-restriction area – meaning no parking on them for any period of time – and the addition of a disabled parking space in High Street is due for marking on 17 October. The request for further double yellow lines up to the Village Hall needs to be the subject of a new Traffic Regulation Order which will be investigated once the other mentioned planned restrictions are in place and assessed. The petition raised by residents of Abbey Road to make this area 'Residents Only' parking to counteract the excessive and inconsiderate parking currently Cont'd on page 3



taking place along there is due to be heard on 21 of October. Advance warning has been received of the possible effects on the village of a National Highways roadworks plan on the A180 which is likely to result in overnight closures, leading to possible diversions through Ulceby.

Coun Hannigan advised that NLC are very much focussing on the issue of health and are disappointed that the NHS services for our area are being rationalised, the proposals for which NLC are opposing during the consultation period. Coun Hannigan further advised that a community diagnostic centre is opening in Scunthorpe in April, as well as a planned surgery centre.





### **Ulceby WI November Update**

Since the last newsletter we have enjoyed a lovely, dry evening buffet in the garden of one of our members. We enjoyed a wonderful selection of food and drink and a quiz with prizes.

In September our brain cells were given a full workout by Nicola Crewe from Lincoln University as we learned all about the two types of DNA and how DNA profiles are created and compared with samples from the scene of the crime or suspects to help to build a case.

On the 15 October, we held the first joint Ulceby Village Hall Association and Ulceby WI Macmillan Coffee Morning from 11.30 to 2pm in the Village Hall. It was very successful. We were well provided with a wide range of cakes, items for the raffle and helpers on the day. Lots of people attended throughout the morning, resulting in us raising £429! Well done and thank you to everyone who helped in any way.

In mid October, Debbie from Andrew's Hedgehog Hospital near Broughton gave us a fascinating talk about how hedgehogs have become endangered over the past decade. She recommended that we should all at least put fresh water out in our gardens in case one uses our garden. She also recommended leaving out cat food, in biscuit form, as their lifestyles have been disrupted by the changing climate and so are awake for more of the year and in need of food. Sometimes they have a second litter of babies but they struggle to put on enough weight in time to get through the winter.

They have already had lots of young hedgehogs admitted to the hospital recently as they have been found abandoned by their mother (she leaves them to make sure she gets enough food to get through the winter!) The evening was rounded off by meeting Carlos, their rescued hedgehog. He arrived at only 96 grammes and was nurtured back to health, but as he developed, they realised he was blind. As he is unaware of night and day or seasons and could not be released, he is taken with Debbie to talks and used to help with education.

The horse box is stripped and ready for the chassis painting. Wheels are heading for sand blasting.


