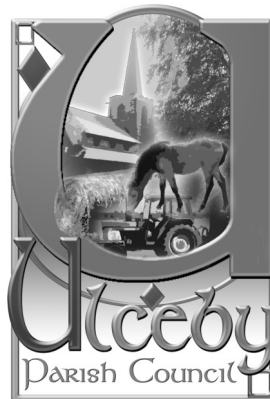

CHAIRMANS REPORT

November 2023 – January 2024

At the November meeting Coun Hannigan reported that Parking Enforcement Officers had visited the village on two occasions recently to monitor parking near Abdal's Restaurant. 2 tickets had been issued to owners of two vehicles which had been parked on the zig zag lines. Coun Rowland was concerned about young people riding electric scooters on the road during darkness and felt this danger should be highlighted. A member of the Ulceby Road Safety Group presented figures which highlighted the problem of vehicle speeding on Spruce Lane. Following a petition from residents of Abbey Road, NLC were drawing up a scheme for parking in this area, which will be presented to the residents there prior to implementation. At this same meeting, it was unanimously agreed that the precept for 2024/25 should be set at £22,000.

Prior to Christmas, Coun Hannigan had had a meeting with the tenant of the Built for Living site when arrangements had been made for visual improvements to be made there. However, at the January (2024) meeting, the tenant at the Built for Living site reported that the new owners of the land had advised him that they wished the site to be totally cleared in order that they could arrange for its' sale for development. Consequently, Built for Living would no longer be operating out of this particular location. Despite this move, it was hoped that arrangements could be made for office accommodation in the village to remain available and the household goods section to be

transferred to Hull.

It was noted that, although the dykes on Killingholme Road had been cleared, as well as the spoil from the dykes being deposited on the verges, so had various fly-tipping items been exposed and the Clerk would approach NLC to request clearance of this. The pathway between West End and the Church has been upgraded and given a hard surface. However, a replacement litter bin for Abbey Road, the reinstatement of the sign at the Crossroads/Carr Road junction, dropped kerbs at Yarborough Court and various pavement repairs throughout the village await conclusions.

As has become the custom, the Parish Council arranged for a lighted fir tree within the railings of the War Memorial to welcome the Christmas period and a vote of thanks was offered to the Parish Council for the generous funding of this year's very successful Over 60's Village Christmas Party.

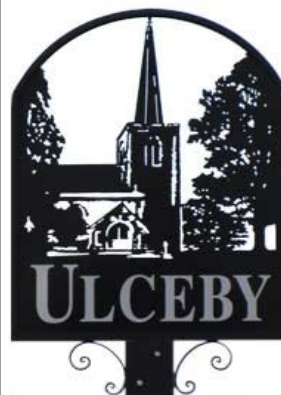

Sit long enough and the bigger fish will become visible, either by crashing on the top - sending shockwaves to waken all, or by swimming close to the edge. The latter is a sight to behold in the now clear water. Perch can be seen with their majestic spiky fin erect, and tench dig into the soft mud for the tastiest scrap of food.

The solitary kingfisher and heron are noted by their absence, being replaced by their cousins the wren and robin. Birdsong can still be heard in the wood at the side of the pond, with the summer chorus now an occasional crow. Nevertheless, it is there and ready to explode into a riot of sound in the spring. For now though, a solitude of peace is the main script for the day.
