

A meeting of Ulceby Parish Council was held on 16th March 2026 at 7.00pm in the village hall.

The Chairman advised the meeting that the resignation of J Marwood from the parish council has been received.

2.**Declaration of Interest on any Agenda Items** – No matters to declare.

3.**Adoption of the minutes of the Monthly Parish Council meeting held on 16th February 2026**

IT WAS RESOLVED that the minutes of the monthly parish council meeting held on 16th February 2026 be confirmed as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

4. **Clerks Updates:**

- N.L.C Community Pot grant for benches and picnic tables at the community garden – application has been submitted, awaiting response from N.L.C.
- Police and Crime Commissioners grant for ANPR(auto speed watch) camera – the grant application for the ANPR has been submitted to The Police and Crime Commissioners grant funding scheme and hopefully the result of this grant application will be known in due course.
- Pot Holes : Abbey Road, Carr Road, Martins Road and outside Worsley Paddock – all reported to N.L.C.

5. **Planning Applications** - Opportunity for one person from each side (members of the public to state within three minutes objections/support of contested applications).

- a) Application PA/2026/150 – Application to determine whether prior approval is required for the demolition of the existing building on site – 10 Gatehouse, Bystable Lane Level Crossing, Carr Road, Ulceby.
The Parish Council raised no objections to this application.

- b) New Police matters to report – An empty property along Abbey Road has been vandalised. The Police are aware.

8. North Lincolnshire Council Matters:

- a) Reports from N.L.C representatives: Cllr Wells made the meeting aware of the current pipeline consultation and that some pot holes on Carr Road have been repaired.
Cllr Hannigan advised that an HGV camera is being trialled at Belton and depending on the success and suitability this type of camera may be useful to Ulceby in the future. Cllr Hannigan advised that the application for picnic benches and seats for the community garden will be considered by cabinet next week and hopefully there will be a positive outcome. Cllr Hannigan advised that an application for funding from the community pot for a SID for Spruce lane – to replace the N.L.C owned SID would be considered by N.L.C.
- b) Community Speed Watch – No update to receive.
- c) Road Safety : The URSG asked the parish council to consider purchasing a SID to be positioned on Spruce lane (replacing the existing SID owned by N.L.C which is to be removed). The clerk advised that £500 will be remaining from the speed signs budget for 2025/6 and a community grant could be applied for to fund the remaining cost. It was noted that only the sign is required as Ulceby PC have already adopted the existing post on which this SID sign will be positioned. (The ANPR sign will have a new post, the cost of which has been submitted within the grant application to the PCC). The meeting agreed that the clerk should submit an application for a SID to the N.L.C community pot fund.
- d) New matters to report: No new matters to report.

The meeting agreed to keep the objection raised by Ulceby Parish Council to this planning application with N.L.C as they felt until the weight restriction has some demarcation, there is no legal obligation for HGV's, legitimately entering the weight limit zone, to enter or exit by a certain route and therefore Ulceby village could still see an increase in HGV's travelling through the village.

10. Environmental and Village issues

- a) Station Road – land for community garden:
 - i) Update on progress made – Cllr Hulatt advised that the community garden has its first anniversary this month and Cllr Hulatt has prepared an interesting and informative article detailing the progress made on this project this year. It was agreed that this article should be posted on the village social media page and the Link magazine. It was suggested that the community pay-back team be thanked for their contribution to this project.
- b) New village matters:
 - i) New village matters – It was noted that the road surface in and around the Hallcroft area urgently needs repair/resurfacing.
Cllr Burdin advised that she can no longer undertake the flag raising duties – it was agreed that this 'volunteer' job would be posted on social media.
