

A meeting of Ulceby Parish Council was held on 19th May 2026 at 7.00pm in the village hall.

PUBLIC FORUM

URSG representative advised the meeting that the A180 and M180 will have preliminary works undertaken and any further works decided upon may take up to 5 years to complete.

URSG hope that the existing SID will remain in place and work alongside the ANPR camera for a period of time. The new SID (ownership Ulceby PC is being progressed). The post for the ANPR camera has been ordered and paid for – waiting for N.L.C to advise of their installation date.

The highest speed recorded on Spruce Lane this month is 105mph. The community speed watch team have undertaken monitoring on Skitter hill and recorded 300 vehicle movements in one hour, a number were exceeding the speed limit and some were abusive.

A new Inspector has been appointed to Barton Police Station and URSG have asked that the Police monitor the weight limit restriction zone carefully.

- Police and Crime Commissioners grant for ANPR(auto speed watch) camera – this grant has been awarded – the equipment has been received. The invoice has been sent to the Police and crime Commissioners office for the 50% grant to be provided to the parish council – not received to date.
- Parish Council vacancy – The position has been advertised – one application received to date.
- Pot Holes : Abbey Road, Carr Road, Martins Road and outside Worsley Paddock, Hallcroft road surface. Pot hole repairs have been undertaken on Martins Road and Abbey Road – one pot hole on Abbey Road may need further attention. The pot hole repair outside Worsley Paddock has been undertaken. The repairs to Hallcroft road surface have been requested to be undertaken in August during the school holidays.

Some of the trees planted by Humber Forest have not survived, hopefully they will be replanted in the autumn.

A discussion took place regarding the proposed MUGA facility planned for the playing fields by the village hall association. It was agreed that the parish council would not be involved in the planning application process.
